

Udsigten – a new setting for forensic psychiatry

In November 2021, The Mental Health Centre Sct. Hans will introduce a new, modern building with 8 wards. The building has been named *Udsigten* and will accommodate the closed wards within specialised forensic psychiatry. This means that all closed forensic psychiatry wards at the Mental Health Centre Sct. Hans and in Glostrup will be moved into *Udsigten*.

What will be new about *Udsigten*?

Udsigten has been designed using natural materials in light rooms. There are good acoustics and views overlooking green areas. All rooms have their own shower and toilet, as well as improved conditions for visiting relatives, including special areas designed for children. In terms of day-to-day life, there will be easier access to outdoor areas and various activity rooms. For example, there is a warm water pool, a gym and a café.

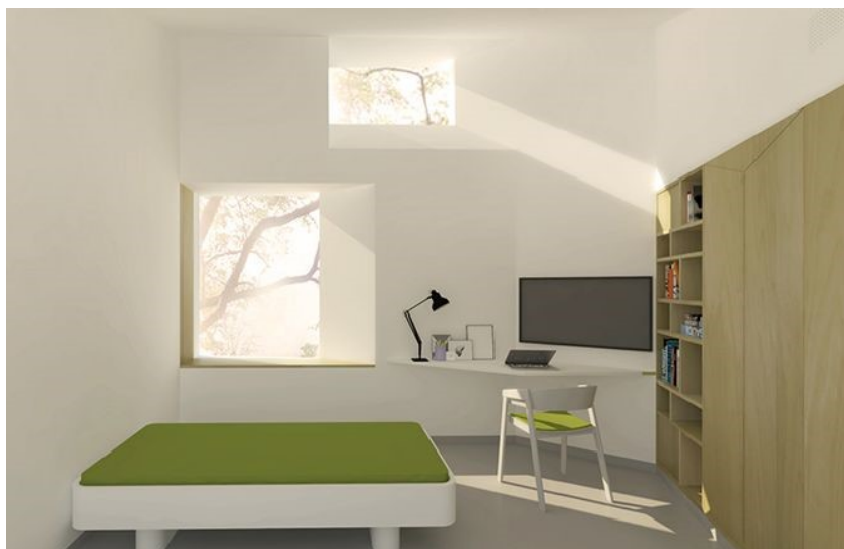
As a whole, the new setting provides more space and the opportunity for a more varied everyday life during your stay.
