### **Scientific focus**

Epidemiology, suicidal behavior, psychopathology and early intervention in psychosis. Have worked with suicide prevention at a national level since 1997. Danish representative in a task force under Nordic Council of Ministers identifying 15 years shortening of life expectancy in schizophrenia. One of the PI's in iPSYCH, the Lundbeck Foundation Initiative for Integrative Psychiatric Research, investigating genetic and environmental causes of mental disorders. PI for the large Danish High Risk and Resilience Study VIA 7, and second wave VIA 11.
